Stanley is doing wonderful. He is keeping himself busy with school assignments. Jeremiah is fine. He is now 11<sup>th</sup> months old. He began to walk last month. Now he is trying to talk. He loves to laugh, plays, and eats. We thank God for these new adventures he gave us with Jeremiah. He has brought nothing but joy to our family.

## Haiti and its Conditions

Please pray for Haiti's conditions. The current conditions are very hostile and displeased. There has never be a time in our lives where we felt so insecure. "It Is Scary!" There is No words to express the conditions of experiencing here this year. "It is not the corona virus!" "It is the insecurity, the violence, and the kidnappings taking place". It is the student being abducted from school and being kill; seeing their body cut open to remove their organs. It is the story of pastors and their wives, get robbed, kidnapped, and raped on their way to and from church or business. It is the stress of trying to hurry up to get home by 6 pm eastern standard time because it is very dark and unsafe to be on the road. A curfew has been placed due to the current crimes, violence, and civil unrest, that are taking place in the streets. Sadly, the local police are lacking resources to respond effectively to serious criminal incidents, and the emergency responders are rare to see.

The churches are doing very well. To welcome the New year, we had a 3-day end of the year revival. On the last day of the revival which was 31<sup>st</sup> the service last up until 1 A.M. (the Haitian people use the 31<sup>st</sup> of December as their Thanksgiving Day to thank the Lord a great year and its protection.) It was a great accomplishment! Afterwards, we eat and drink their traditional pumpkin squash soup and ginger tea with them to celebrate the Haitian Independence Day. Which also celebrate on New Year's Day. In additions to celebration, we had 2 teens saved.

## Roselande Health

Roselande is not doing well. She has twisted her left leg last Wednesday while crossing a main road. She could not stand nor walk with her feet. It was extremely hard for her to even get up go to the restroom. She is doing much better now. Please continue pray for her! As you all probably know the medical conditions here in Haiti is not very pleasant. Specially with her lupus conditions. Beside her leg being twisted she is improving with the lupus. She is currently seeing an herbalist. which she gave her a lot of herbal remedies to drinks. Her liaison, and open wound started to be cleared from her skin. She only had some mild joint pain. She is currently down on the dose of her steroid and other medications. The herbal remedies and your prayers seem to help her very well with her illness.
